

Attention All Students—Special Election Referendum for the Fall GSBA Election

This fall GSBA is attempting to amend the GSBA Constitution and change the By Laws to better serve students. An initiative of this nature has never before appeared on the ballot or been presented to students. The amendment calls for club disputes and club conduct cases to be heard in front of the GSBA Judicial Board instead of Class Officers. This change gives the opportunity for clubs and students to present their cases in front of a trained and impartial board. This switch will also give Class Officers more time to devote to planning class events and chartering new clubs to expand student activities.

In order for this amendment to take effect at least 1,700 students need to vote, and two-thirds of those students need to approve of the change. The U.S. Presidential Election is just around the corner and this is a great opportunity to practice your civic duty and get out and vote. The amendment will appear at the top of every ballot when voting begins on Monday September 22nd.
